### Analysis - Top 3

 <b>1</b> Average Rank 19.8	Singapore ranked 1st in 2 different rank categories/indexes (Crime & Terrorism Indices) along with a 3rd and 4th place ranking in Un-employment Rate and Life Expectancy categories respectively. These 4 rankings helped the overall ranking in a positive way by offsetting some of the lower ranked categories for this country (Consumer Price Index #63 and Quality of Health Care #40) which resulted in the country having an overall rank of #1.
 <b>2</b> Average Rank 20.5	Qatar ranked 1st in 3 different rank categories/indexes (Global Terrorism, Un-employment Rate and Disaster Risk) however was also ranked quite low in 2 other categories (Pollution Index #66 and Consumer Price Index #46) which slightly lowered Qatar's rank calculation to #2 overall.
 <b>3</b> Average Rank 21.7	Switzerland didn't have any categories ranked #1, however they were ranked #3, #5, and #8 (three times ranked #8) in Life Expectancy, Global Peace, Crime, Pollution and Un-employment Rate respectively which really averaged out the overall rank. The factor that lowered Switzerland's rank substantially was the fact the country was ranked last (#70) in Consumer Price Index which drove the overall rank down to #3.

### Overview

The Safety Index Dashboard consists of an overall index ranking system which ranks 70 different countries across 10 different ranking categories. All categories are weighted the same, resulting in an overall final safety index rank generated by calculating a final rank of the sum of all individual category ranks. An average rank is also generated which provides greater detail, specifically in the measurement of difference between ranks. The individual rank categories cover a wide range of various global safety related indexes from life expectancy to disaster risk, which include the most up to date data from a variety of different sources which are listed below.
